SPECIAL MEETING
May 2, 2024

The Town Council of Bogue met Thursday, May 2, 2024, at the Bogue Town Hall, 121 Chimney Branch Road.

Mayor Robert O’Chat called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor O’Chat led a prayer.

Agenda

Councilman Dale made a motion to accept the agenda. Councilman Padgett seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Workshop

The Town Council discussed what to have in the Budget for 2024-2025, Clerk Southard will have a Draft Budget for the Town Council to review at the regular May 20, 2024, Town Council meeting.

The Town Council discussed how Special Use Permits will be approved; for example, how long can a business have music outside if approved. After much discussion, the Town Council stated that it would be on a case by case basis.
